

Contributor Agreement concerning the contribution entitled

(hereinafter “the Contribution” which term shall include all tables, diagrams, photographs and other material supplied by the Author)

(hereinafter “the Editor”) to be published by Palgrave Macmillan, a division of Macmillan Publishers Limited (company number 785998) whose registered office is at Houndmills, Basingstoke, Hampshire RG21 (hereinafter “the PUBLISHER”).

1. In consideration of one complimentary copy of the Work to be delivered to the Author on publication of the Work by the Publisher, the Author hereby grants to the Publisher the sole and exclusive right and licence throughout the world to produce, print, publish, copy, store in any medium by electronic means and otherwise exploit the Contribution or any part of the Contribution or any derivative of the Contribution in all languages in every form or format whether now known or hereafter invented, including without limitation print, audio, digital and electronic form and in each case to license others including without limitation associate companies of the Publisher to do any or all of the same. The Publisher shall have absolute discretion as to the exercise, sale or other dealing of the rights granted herein. The Author will retain copyright in the Contribution. Consent for the Author to republish the Contribution after the date of Publication of the Work in a collection of his or her own writings without charge shall not be unreasonably withheld.

2. The Author hereby warrants to the Publisher and the Publisher’s licensees that:
- (a) the Author has full power and authority to make this Agreement;
  - (b) the Contribution is original except for such copyright material from other works for which the Author has obtained permission to enable the Author to grant the rights set out herein;
  - (c) the Contribution will not infringe any copyright in any part of the world or any trademark, patents or other rights of any other person and that the Author has not granted any rights in respect of the Contribution inconsistent with the grant herein contained;
  - (d) the Contribution shall contain nothing obscene, defamatory, objectionable, indecent or of a libellous or scandalous nature and that any advice, recipe, formula or instruction contained in the Contribution will not, if followed accurately cause any injury, illness or damage to the user; and
  - (e) nothing in the Contribution infringes any duty of confidentiality which the Author may owe to anyone else

The Author shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Publisher from and against any loss, cost, injury or damage (including any legal costs or expenses properly incurred) arising as a result of a breach or alleged breach of any of the warranties contained in this Clause 2.

The Publisher may in the Publisher’s absolute discretion compromise or settle any claim covered by this indemnity without prejudice to the Publisher’s rights hereunder.

The Author hereby asserts to the Publisher and the Publisher's licencees the Author's moral right of paternity in the Contribution. The Author irrevocably and unconditionally waives the Author's moral right as provided in the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 to the extent the Publisher deems necessary to allow the Publisher to exercise and license the exercise of the rights granted to the Publisher under this Agreement.

3. The Author hereby empowers the Publisher to take in the Author's name but at the Publisher's expense any action, legal or otherwise, that the Publisher may consider necessary to protect its rights under this Agreement.

4. This license shall continue for the full term of copyright in the Contribution and any extension, renewal or revival thereof.


5. The Publisher may make such editorial amendments to the Contribution as the Publisher considers necessary.

6. Nothing herein contained shall oblige or require the Publisher to publish the Contribution now or at any time in the future.

7. Where the Author comprises two or more persons (a) the Author agrees that they are jointly and severally responsible to the Publisher for the performance of all the Author's obligations contained in this Agreement; and (b) the Publisher shall divide equally between each of the persons comprising the Author any payments or copies of the Work herein due to the Author; and (c) the first named person listed as Author above is hereby appointed as the representative of the Author and any and all instructions, comments or approvals given by that person to the Publisher that do not conflict with the provisions of this Agreement shall be binding on each of the persons comprising the Author as though given by each of them.

8. This Agreement shall be subject to the laws of England.
